## CMSC 434 Essay Rubric

For each essay question, you are asked to take a position on something. You may also be asked to summarize something. Your essay should stand alone as a piece of writing that makes sense on its own. It should be understandable by a recent computer science graduate who may not have taken an HCI course.

Example question: What is cyberpsychology and why is it so important?

To answer this, you need to first summarize what cyberpsychology is. Then make a thesis statement: "Cyberpsychology is important because [......]". The rest of your answer provides evidence to defend your

Thesis Statement

Evidence

Organization

Citations	
10 points	2 or more reliable sources are cited. One source can be the textbook, but another source can be another assigned reading or one you find on your own. Citations are in ACM SIGCHI Papers format.
5 points 5 points: 0 points:	2 or more sources are cited, but at least one is less reliable than Wikipedia. Only 1 source cited. No sources cited.
Grammar	
10 points: 5 points: 0 points:	Consistent and appropriate writing style, no spelling or grammar errors. Fewer than 3 punctuation, capitalization, spelling, or other grammatical errors. Poor sentence structure, Inappropriate language, or 3 or more grammar errors.
